

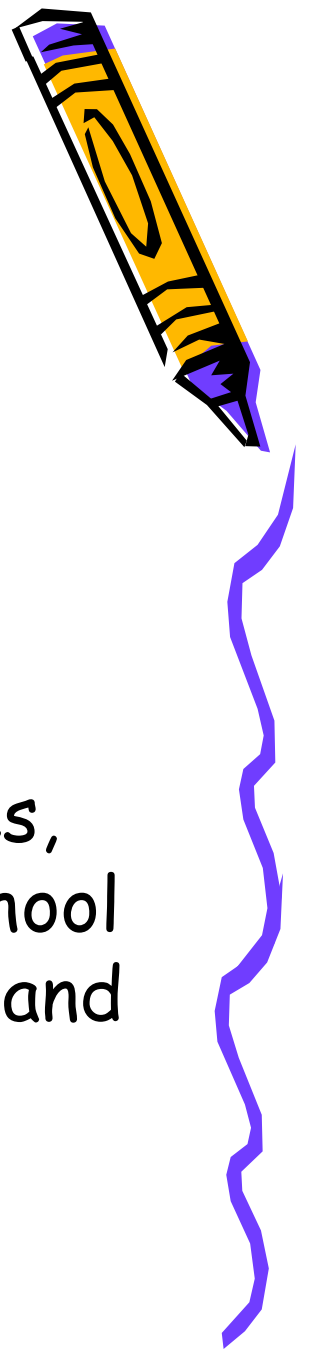

- The program utilizes personnel, agencies, and programs both in and out of the school building which relate to student health and success in school.



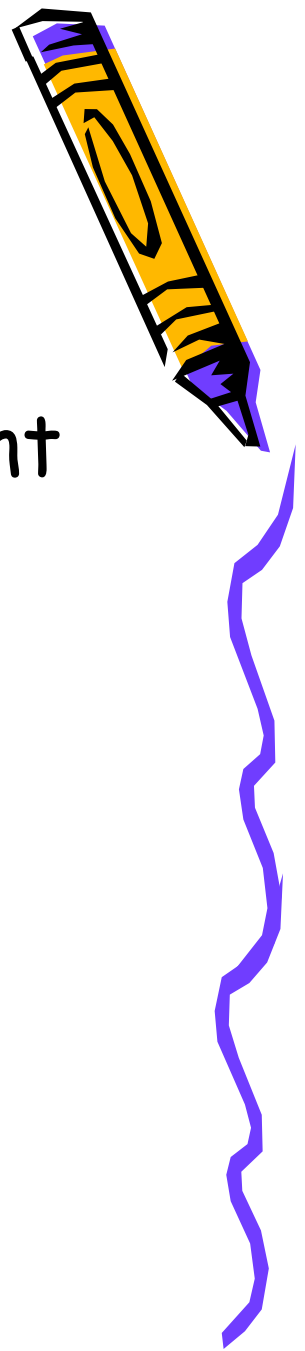

- Individual health education is also available.



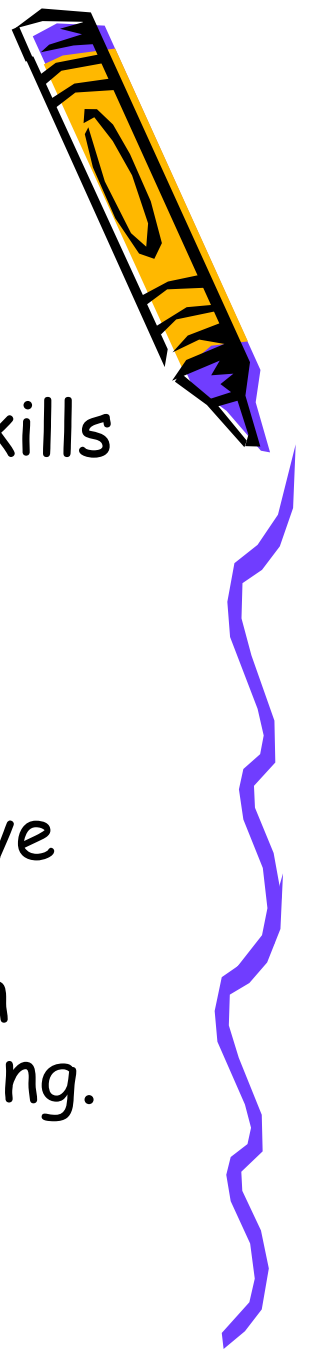
Immunization Records



- The school health services program is responsible for maintaining student health records.
- Immunization requirements are established by Arkansas State Law.
- The AR Dept. of Health conducts yearly record reviews to monitor school compliance with the laws.



Conway Public Schools School Nurses



- The Conway School District employs 12 Registered Nurses as school nurses.
- Each RN is licensed through the AR State Board of Nursing.
- RNs have the skills and abilities to practice independently, supervise non-licensed assistive personnel, and delegate care in the school setting.



School Nurse Schedule

- Each school nurse is assigned to specific schools. The nurses are available during school hours from 8:00 until 4:00.
- The CHS West nurse is available Monday thru Friday during school hours.
